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

- 3 The benefits given to the employees to the grant-in-aid school of Government of Gujarat will not be made available by the State Government to the employees of proposed school or in other words State Government shall not bear any liability in respect of the proposed school.
- 4 The proposed school shall not use the premises including staff, play ground or any moveable or immovable property of any other school registered under the respective Act of State Government.
- 5 The State Government will not bear any financial or administrative responsibility of the proposed school. The State Government will not be responsible, if the school/institution breaches of any rules/norms or regulations laid down by above said board.
- 6 The institution shall have to obtain necessary permission of Government of India and other concerned authorities where it is necessary.
- 7 This NOC is valid for six months from the date of issue.
- 8 As soon as the School gets affiliation with CBSE, it will have to submit a copy of the letter of affiliation to the Gujarat Secondary & Higher Secondary Education Board, Gandhinagar as well as Education Department of the State Government and will get itself registered at Gujarat Secondary & Higher Secondary Education Board, Gandhinagar.



7. The recruitment of the teacher will required to be done as per Schedule-F.



The proposal to start second shift in Firdaus Amrut Centre School (CBSE), Shahibaug, Ahmedabad. (Std 1 to 8)

CERTIFICATE

On condition of full compliance with the following Acts & Rules, this office has no objection if CBSE give permission for two shifts. This "NOC" is issued from June 2024. If school fails to abide by the rules then this "NOC" will be considered as cancelled.

1. RTE Act 2009 and RTE The provisions of Rules 2012 have to be strictly followed.
2. The Provisions of Mumbai Primary Education Act 1947 and 1949 must be strictly followed.
3. The provisions of Gujarat Self Supporting Schools (Fee Regulation) Act 2017 should be strictly followed
4. All the rules of C.B.S.E by Laws must be strictly followed.
5. The period of NOC approval of shift method given to the school will be up to the period given by C.B.S.E.
6. The number of students in the school cannot be taken more than the norms of C.B.S.E.
7. In Std-1 to 8, the number should not be more than 40 per class.
8. According to RTE, 25% vacancies in Std-1 should be kept vacant for the children of weak and deprived group.
9. C.B.S.E approved classes and students should be included in the shift system
10. The hours and days of school academic work and the time of recess during the year shall be as per RTE norms.
11. In shift method students have to get the consent of the guardian to go in that shift.
12. The shift system of C.B.S.E will have to be implemented after getting approval.
13. No more classes can be run than the approved classes.
14. This approval is valid only for standards 1 to 8.
